- (1) the facts on which the statement is based;
- (2) all relevant documents and supporting information;
- (3) a proposed resolution to the problem to the extent known and available to the complainant at the time the complaint is filed; and

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The Staff Member will review the actions taken to address any noncompliance. If the Staff Member determines that the School District addressed the noncompliance, the matter will be closed. If the Staff Member determines that the School District failed to address the noncompliance, the Staff Member will report to act to Administrator for appropriate enforcement action.
